



# PASSION BEYOND MEDICINE

Inspiration and influences promoting wellbeing beyond the field of medicine

DHQ will be hosting an exhibition themed “*Passion Beyond Medicine*” at Aspire Gallery, Paddington, over two weekends Saturday 4<sup>th</sup>, Sunday 5<sup>th</sup>, Saturday 11<sup>th</sup>, Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> of June 2022. The opening night will be held on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2022 in line with CrazySocks4Docs Day. The exhibition will feature works by current and former doctors and medical students, that inspire and complement or enhance their medical practice. The exhibition will celebrate the creativity of Queensland doctors and medical students, promote the benefits to wellbeing of engagement in activities beyond the work environment, and create a space to develop a community around passions beyond medicine.

DHQ is calling for expressions of interest from current or former Queensland medical professionals and medical students. Expressions of interest will be open until the 6<sup>th</sup> of May 2022.

## ABOUT DHQ

Doctors’ Health Queensland (DHQ) supports the health and wellbeing of medical practitioners and medical students throughout their careers in Queensland, understanding that this work benefits the community as a whole in improving the delivery of quality care to patients. Doctors experience the same wide range of health issues as others in the community, as well as conditions specifically related to the stresses of professional practice, yet medical practitioners may find it challenging accepting the role as a patient, and many fail to seek help in a timely manner. The organisation helpline is staffed on a voluntary basis by doctors who seek to provide support, advice and assistance to colleagues who have concerns and may be in difficulty.

## REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION PROCESS

The DHQ exhibition will only be open to medical students, and current and former medical practitioners.

Any visual medium, with the exception of audio-visual displays, may be submitted. Two-dimensional artworks will be limited to 1m x 1.5m, and sculpture pieces should be less than 1m x 1m x 1m.

All submissions will be reviewed by the organising committee for inclusion in the exhibition. Due to space limitations, it may not be possible to include all work submitted for consideration. Work may be exhibited for sale if the artist wishes with discussion from Aspire Gallery.

Details of artwork including dimensions medium and representative photograph along with a short artist bio should be included with submissions using the application form (link below).

## COST OF ENTRY

Artist submission to the exhibition is free. NB It is the responsibility of the Exhibiting Artist to deliver, package and transfer the Exhibition Pieces to and from the Agreed Space and it is the responsibility of the artist to hold adequate insurance for their artwork.

If an artist chooses to sell their work at the exhibition, they will be asked to donate 10% of the sale price to the Doctors' Health Advisory Service QLD (DHAS(Q)) trading as DHQ – a charitable organisation – in lieu of commission. An additional 2-3% will be deducted for eftpos charges by Aspire. Price to be determined by the artist.

Further details regarding the exhibitions celebratory opening night on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2022 are yet to be announced.
